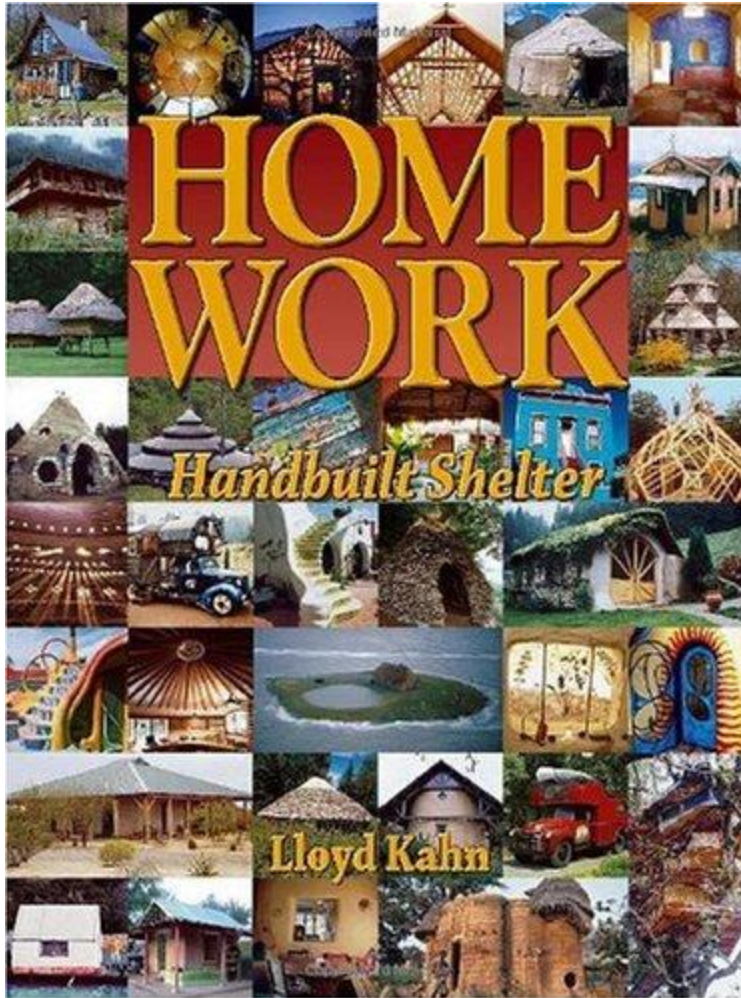


# Home Work: Handbuilt Shelter by Lloyd Kahn
